PRIVACY POLICY

General Provisions

The IQUICK platform (hereinafter referred to as the Service) is one of the main tasks before itself to protect the confidential and personal data of its customers (hereinafter referred to as the Users) - visitors to the website <https://iquick.io> (hereinafter the Site) including, but not limited to users of training services, participants in the partnership program, leadership program, bonus program. Any changes to the privacy policy will be published in this section. Completed registration of the User means that he is acquainted with this policy and accepts it unconditionally.

All information posted on the site of the IQUICK Service is stored on reliable servers in accordance with international privacy standards and is completely encrypted. One of the main priorities of the Service IQUICK is to ensure the safety and security of the means and personal data of the User.

1. Reception, storage, and processing of personal data

1.1. This Privacy Policy regulates all aspects of the interaction between the Service and Users in matters of the transfer and processing of personal data. All data that the User transmits through the Site shall be processed and stored.

1.2. This Privacy Policy comes into effect from the moment of registration of the User and his consent to the Cooperation Agreement expressed through the registration of the account.

1.3. Service reserves the exclusive right to change the Privacy Policy at any time without notice to Users. Changes come into effect from the moment of publication on the Site. If the User continues to use the services, he confirms by his actions that he is acquainted with the current contents of the Privacy Policy and accepts all changes.

1.4. When registering an account on the Site, the User must confirm that he is acquainted with the terms of cooperation. Registration of an account confirms the User's decision to provide personal data and consent to their collection, processing, storage and use under this Privacy Policy.

1.5. The user is fully responsible for the correctness of the personal data provided.

1.6. Personal data of Users is used by the Service for:

- quality provision of training services, provision of training materials and/or participation in the Service's partner program;
- unimpeded provision of the User with access to the Site;
- timely informing users about services;
- registration of a personal account and access to all possibilities of the Service;
- Notifications about changes in the assortment, quality, content, terms of use of the Services;
- Restore access in case of password loss;
- conducting sociological research to identify the needs of users, search for technical problems;
- feedback from the Service;
- improving the service, assessing the level of service.

1.7. Personal data of users can be used for marketing activities: e-mailing, news on behalf of the Service, offering new services.

1.8. Personal data can be used to inform users about the activity of a personal account: accessible training materials, available information about consultations/meetings, and also partnering activity.

1.9. The Service undertakes to ensure the confidentiality of the personal data of the Users when they are collected, processed and stored.

1.10. The user can not refuse the transfer and use of personal information.

2. Consent to the collection, storage and use of personal information

2.1. When registering an account on the Site, the Service asks the Users to provide personal information that will be used to use the account and services. The real e-mail of the User, contact and other data may be required for initial access to a personal account and service.

2.2. During the registration process, the User will be provided with a personal password that will become part of his / her personal account.

2.3. By providing personal information to the Service, the User voluntarily agrees to its use and processing.

2.4. The service can notify users about new services and current news. The user can refuse such mailings by notifying the Service.

3. Age of Users

3.1. Registration of the account and the use of the service are allowed by the User - sane person, who has the status of full civil capacity according to legislative norms; older than 18 (eighteen) years of age; excluding citizens of the following countries: Canada, British Columbia, Nova Scotia, Nunavut, Saskatchewan New Brunswick, Newfoundland and Labrador Northwest Territories, Yukon; United States: Alabama Wyoming, Nebraska. South Korea, - over the age of 19 (nineteen) years; and for citizens of the following countries: Taiwan, Tunisia, Japan, - over the age of 20 (twenty) years; and for citizens of the following countries: Bahrain, Guinea, Honduras, Egypt, Cameroon, Cote d'Ivoire, Lesotho, Madagascar, Monaco, Singapore, United States of America: Mississippi, Puerto Rico, New York, Chad, - over 21 years of age (twenty-one) years who, with his will and consciously ready and willing to use the Services, understands its rights and assumes the obligations expressly implied, as well as set out in this and other IQUICK agreements.

4. Changing personal information

4.1. The user has access to edit personal information in his account through the web interface of the Site in the "My Account" section.

5. Account Security

5.1. Until the User has registered or authorized in the system using the login and password, all movements on the site remain absolutely anonymous, which does not exclude the User's obligation to comply with the terms of this Agreement.

5.2. Access to the account of the User can be obtained only if there is a user ID ("Login"), a unique and secret password ("Password") and additional data (login, the password is "Credentials"). The user must choose his own unique "Login". "Password" will be assigned automatically at registration, in the future the User can choose his own unique "Password" in the Personal Area in the section "My Account" - "Password".

5.3. Personal data can be obtained by the Service only with the permission of the User at the time of registration on the site. If necessary, Service IQUICK asks the User for consent to the use of his personal data.

5.4. The information provided to the User is prohibited to be published in public sources or transferred to third parties without the written prior consent of the owners of the Service.

5.5. The user is responsible for any unauthorized use of the "Credentials" since this will be considered as an act committed by him. In order to avoid trouble, the User must keep personal information secret, and also make every effort to ensure their confidentiality.

6. Personal Information

6.1. The personal data of the User, the provision of which is required from the User during the cooperation, is securely stored in the electronic systems of the Service, considered confidential and

protected. In accordance with the policy of the Service, information about customers is disclosed to non-affiliated third parties only with the consent of the User or in accordance with the requirements of regulatory legal regulation. Personal information may include but is not limited to, the name, date of birth, email address, phone number, social account data, instant messaging (instant messaging) accounts, and others.

6.2. Use of personal data of Service Members.

6.3. The participant agrees that personal data specified by him during registration (login, FI, country, city, telephone, e-mail, etc.) will be processed by the Service IQUICK system.

6.4. Service IQUICK has the right to inform participants of the specified contacts (e-mail distribution, SMS-dispatch, dispatch in messengers, etc.)

6.5. Service IQUICK has the right to submit a review of the Participant on the site: IQUICK with the indication of its contact details - name, city after publication by the Participant of such a response to the Service IQUICK system on the Internet.

6.6. The Service does not have the right to disclose any such data unless it may be necessary to conduct operations or other activities for the User's maintenance, and at the same time, provided that the generally accepted confidentiality obligations are complied with or when required by law. Access to such information is provided only for business purposes to persons, such as employees of the Service and/or third parties, who need this information to provide services to customers and/or the Service. In all cases, physical, electronic and procedural controls are used to protect such information. These controls are reasonably designed to: ensure the security and confidentiality of client documentation and information; protection against any perceived threats or dangers, for the safety or integrity of the client's documentation or information; protection from unauthorized access or use of documentation or customer information that can lead to significant damage or inconvenience to the customer.

7. Cookies

7.1. The service uses cookies on the Site to track information about Users and used services. Cookies are data transmitted by the User's Web browser when they visit the Site and are stored on the User's personal computer. The service uses cookies to track the User's visits to sections of the Site, counting referrals through internal links, and monitoring traffic.

8. Personal Security

8.1. Service makes every effort to prevent unauthorized access to the User's personal account and disclosure of its personal information. However, the transfer of data via the Internet and Web services does not guarantee absolute protection and require special attention from Users.

8.2. The user is obliged to keep his password secret and not transfer it to third parties.

8.3. If a password (access) to a personal account is lost, the User can request his recovery by automated service on the Site using his personal email address. The password will be contained in the letter that will be sent from the Service to this address.

8.4. After receiving the temporary password, the user is recommended to set a new password.

8.5. The user monitors the entire flow of personal information when working with the site.

8.6. Service IQUICK reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to terminate the access of the User who violates this User Agreement to the Services both in whole and in part, including stopping or temporarily suspending the User's access to the Personal Area. A user whose access to the Services has been terminated or whose Information has ceased to be valid does not have the right to re-create the new Account (including using the e-mail address specified earlier by the User on the IQUICK Service) without special authorization Service IQUICK, and also such User has no right to use the Credentials of another User to access the IQUICK Service.

8.7. In the process of using the IQUICK Services (including when registering, interacting with other Users through the IQUICK Service interface, placing Ads, viewing the pages of the IQUICK Service, etc.),

the User independently voluntarily decides on the provision of the IQUICK Service .info of personal and other data about the User (name, e-mail address, mobile phone number, as well as any other information provided by the User (including those contained in messages sent to other Users through the form of communication in the interface of the Service IQUICK), information about the User's actions on the Service IQUICK, etc.) for the purposes of executing the User Agreement, and hereby declares its consent to the processing of the Service by IQUICK and its affiliates personal and other (including cross-border transfer to the territory of foreign states ensuring adequate protection of the rights of subjects of personal data) for processing to other Users and / or third parties acting on behalf of C IQUICK, including for the purposes of: providing consulting support to Users, obtaining statistical and analytical data to improve the functioning of the IQUICK Service and / or Services, expanding the range of services provided, receiving information and / or advertising messages. IQUICK or third parties, preventing or suppressing illegal and/or unauthorized actions of Users or third parties, ensuring compliance with the requirements of current legislation. Service IQUICK takes all necessary measures to protect the User's personal data from unauthorized third-party access.

9. Contact information

9.1. The user can contact the representatives of the Service on this Privacy Policy by writing a request by sending the "Help / Contact Us" form, the registered user can also send a request in the section "Technical Support" in the personal account.
